Greetings Booker T. Washington Baysaver Families,

With our 6 -8 who have opted for hybrid learning returning on March 8, we want to assure you that the safety of students, staff, and community members are our utmost priority. With that said, there are a few points of information below we feel that is important for you to know. We appreciate your support in adhering to these guidelines and protocols:

- *Ensure all of your child's information is up-to-date using ParentVue.*
- *In the event, your child experiences any symptoms, please keep them at home.*
- *Ensure your child arrives at school with a mask and has an extra one in their book bag as well as a water bottle.*
- *We will not be permitting parents to walk students to classrooms, however, there will be designated staff throughout the building to guide them to their classroom.*
- *When parents arrive to pick up students for early dismissal due to appointments, you will be greeted by our security officer, asked to remain outside and your child will be brought to you.*
- *If your student is sent to the clinic and you are contacted to pick them up, please make arrangements to do so.*
- *There is a new drop off and pick up procedures. All students will enter with their grades. (6,8 Gym) (7th near the gym at stairwell)*
- *Be sure to have a back-up child care plan in case your child is asked to quarantine.*

It is equally important to share what we have in place to ensure the health and safety of your child:

- *Sanitation stations that include sanitizer and wipes are set up throughout the building.*
- *We have eliminated using lockers*
- *Each classroom has a sanitizing station in the room.*
- *Visible signage as reminders inside and outside of the building*
- *There is a rotating schedule for sanitizing classrooms and common bathrooms throughout the day.*
- *There is a designated room for students who are symptomatic and require isolation.*
