<b>Pants</b> 	Navy Tan Black	Solid Color Appropriate size for waist, length, and student's size	No oversized or baggy pants No jogging suits/sweat-pants No denim/jeans material No skinny jeans/skinny pants/pajama jeans/leggings
<b>Shorts/Skirts/Dresses/Jumpers</b>	Navy/ Tan/Black	Solid Color	No shorter than 3" above the knees No sports shorts No denim/jeans material
<b>Shirts</b> 	Any solid color	<b>Must have collar or turtleneck</b> Must be short or long sleeved, not sleeveless Must be oxford style or polo shirt School logo shirts allowed	<b>Must be appropriate size for student</b> Only <b>ONE</b> shirt with white t-shirt or white camisole underneath No Logos larger than 1 inch No T-shirts except BTW shirts No bare-midriiffs <b>Only white undershirts/camisoles</b> No denim
<b>Sweaters</b>	Any solid color	Pullover/Cardigan No writing/logos	Must wear dress-code shirt underneath
<b>Crewneck Sweatshirts (No hoods)</b>	Any solid color	No writing except School logo shirts ONLY Crew neck long sleeved	Must wear dress-code shirt underneath Only BTW hooded sweatshirts permitted
<b>Shoes</b> 		Closed toe, or lace-up Tennis/athletic (also required for PE class)	<b>No flip-flops/slippers</b> <b>No open-toed shoes</b>
<b>Socks/Tights</b>	Black/brown/ white/Navy	One pair of matching socks Stockings/tights must have feet	No prints/stripes Must be a solid color
<b>Belt</b>			Pants designed for belts must be belted



## Students in dress code

### Other:

Heavy coats, jackets, or fleeces are not to be worn inside the building. All coats must be kept in lockers.

Only solid-color sweaters and crew-neck sweatshirts are appropriate cold-weather wear inside the building.

Only BTW hooded-sweatshirts are permitted.

No string bags or other bags used as "lunch bags" allowed.

Boys Shirts must be tucked in.
