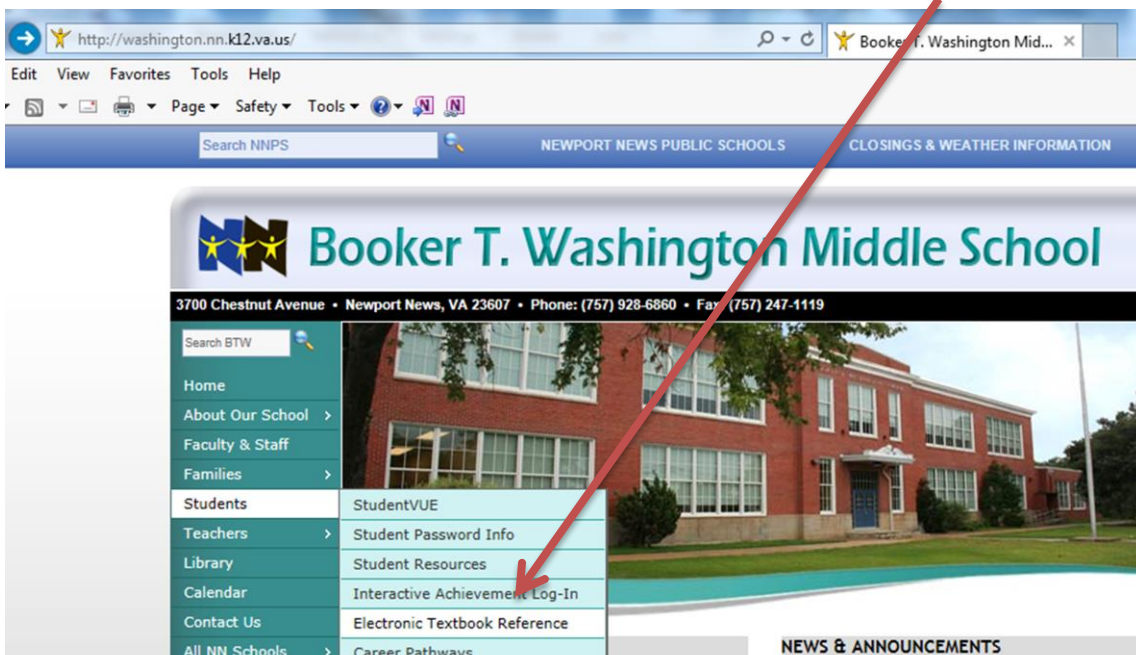
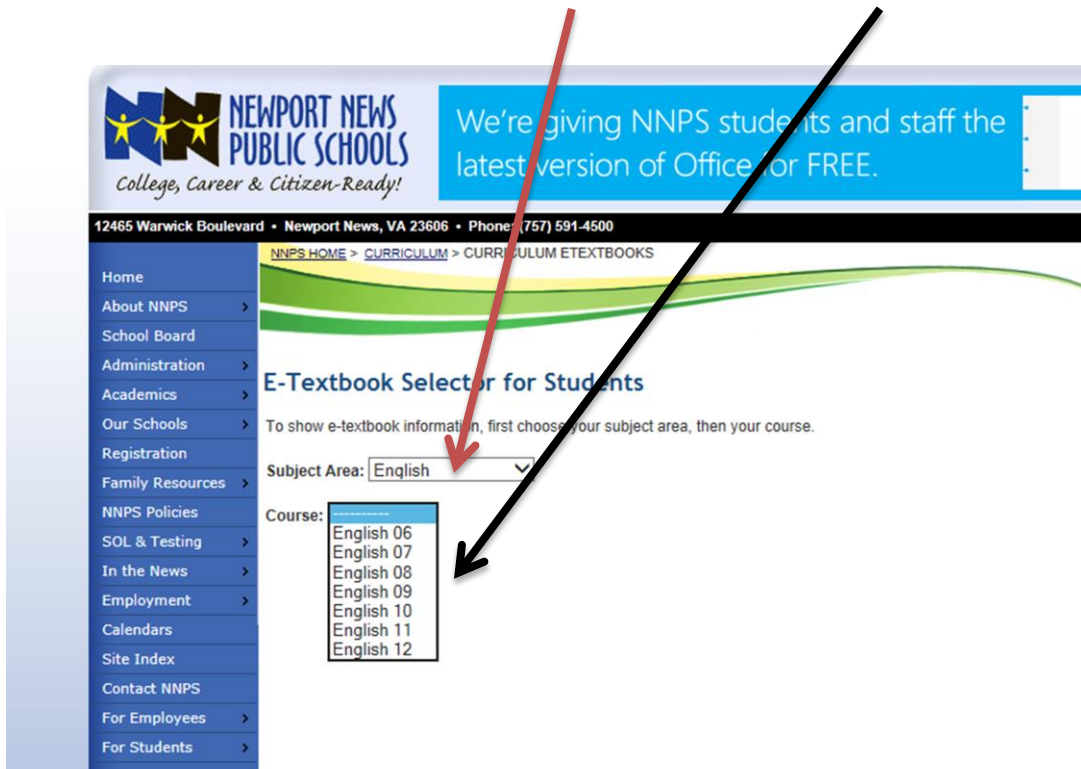

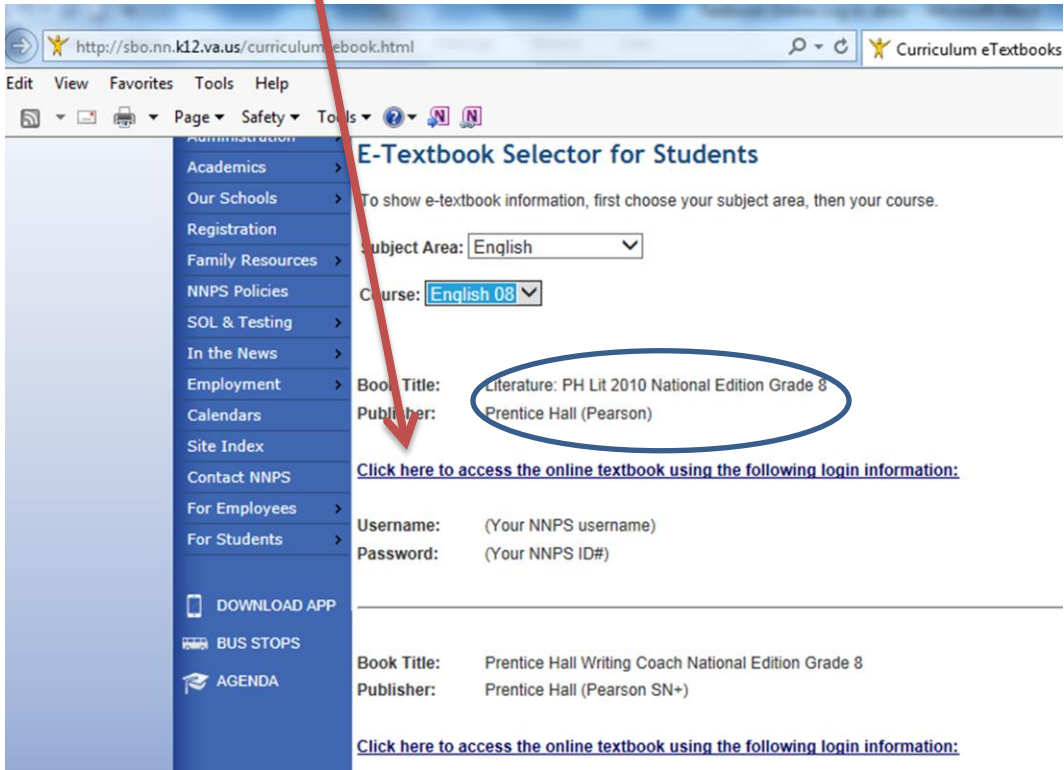
1. From the BTW website, click on Student, then Electronic Textbook Reference



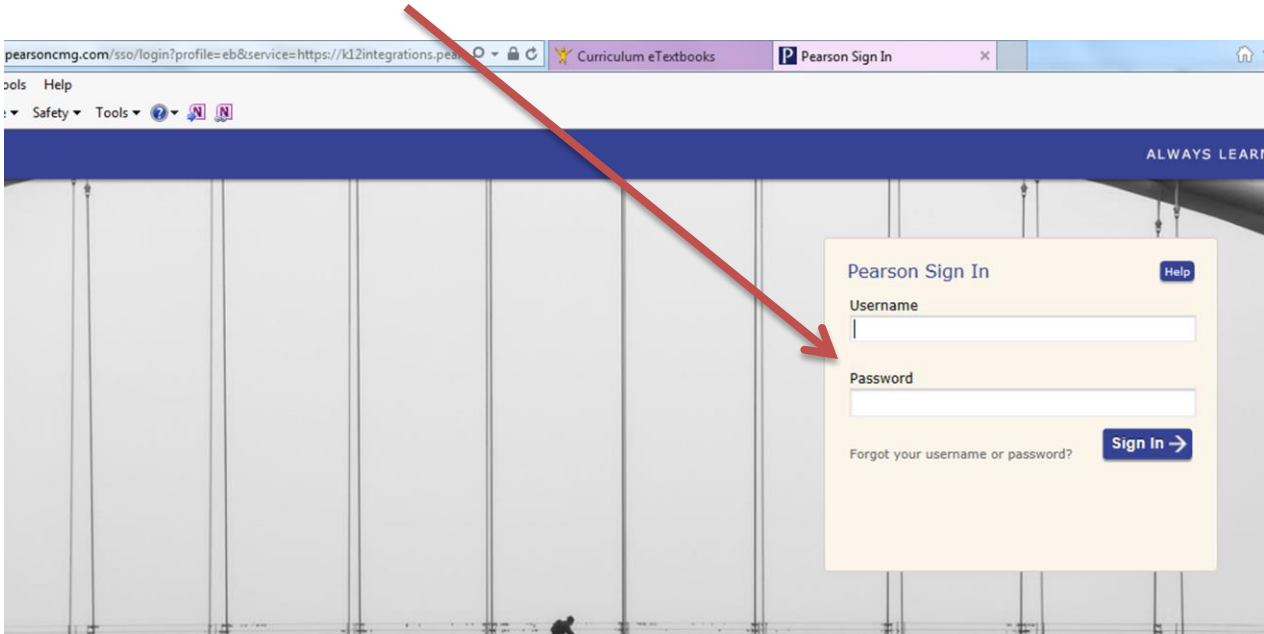
2. Click on English from Subject Area drop down. Next select a grade level.



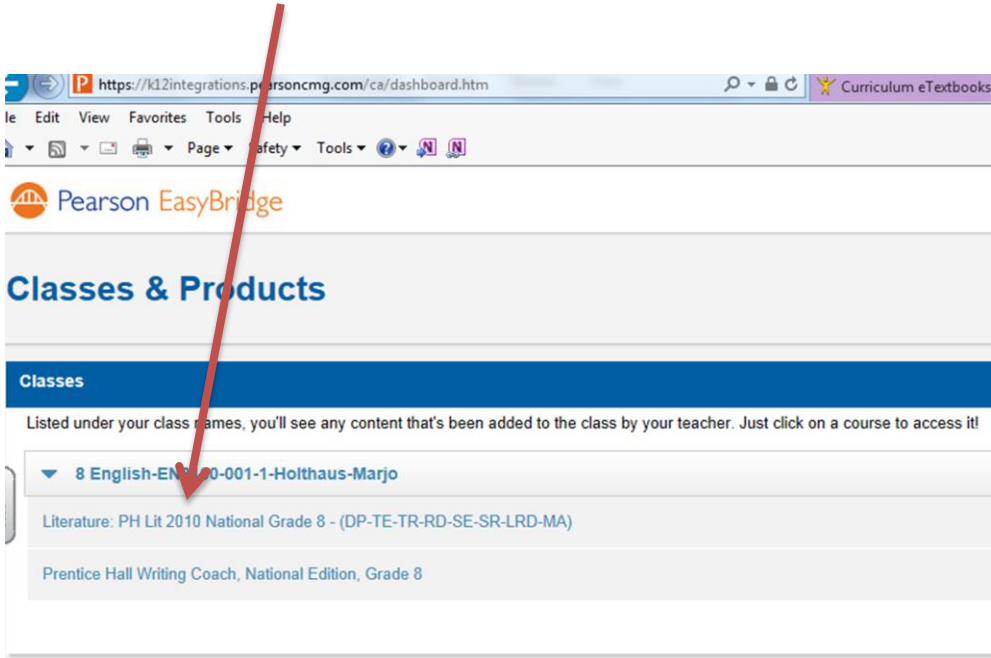
3. Choose the Literature Link.



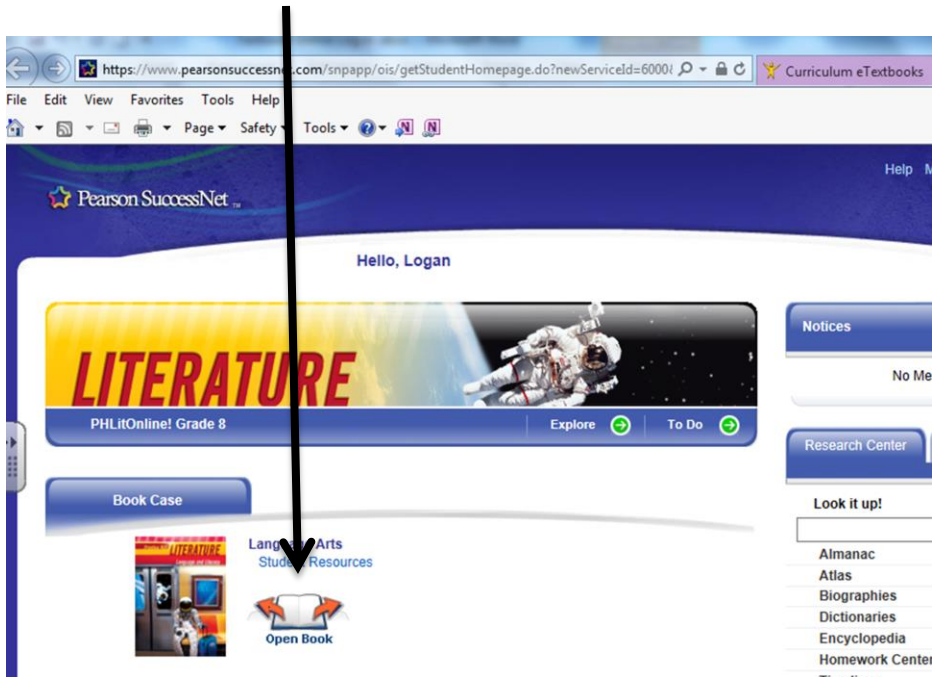
4. Student enters his NNPS Username and his student lunch number for the Password.
